GS stellen plan van aanpak voor landschapsplan Stelling van Amsterdam en Verbinding A8-A9 vast

De provincie Noord-Holland werkt, samen met haar partners, aan het versterken van de Stelling van Amsterdam en het verbeteren van de leefbaarheid en bereikbaarheid in het gebied tussen de A8 en de A9. Hiervoor stellen de partijen een landschapsplan op. Het plan van aanpak om te komen tot het landschapsplan is op 5 februari 2019 vastgesteld door Gedeputeerde Staten (GS).

In mei 2018 concludeerde GS dat het Golfbaanalternatief de beste verbinding tussen de A8 en de A9 is om de UNESCO-waarden van de Stelling van Amsterdam te herstellen en de bereikbaarheid en leefbaarheid in het gebied te verbeteren. Het landschapsplan onderzoekt de mogelijke herstelmaatregelen voor de Stelling van Amsterdam en vervolgens de inpassing van het Golfbaanalternatief in dat landschap.

Participatie

Van belang in het plan van aanpak is de participatie van betrokkenen. De provincie en haar partners vinden dat ook in deze fase bewoners en belangengroepen mee kunnen denken. Het

participatietraject is daarom een belangrijk onderdeel in de aanbesteding voor het opstellen van het landschapsplan.

Samenwerking

De provincie maakt het landschapsplan samen met de Vervoerregio Amsterdam en de gemeenten Zaanstad, Beverwijk, Velsen en Uitgeest. Ook de gemeente Heemskerk en Rijkswaterstaat zijn nauw betrokken bij het project, evenals het ministerie van Onderwijs, Cultuur en Wetenschap (OCW).

Vervolg

In het eerste kwartaal van 2019 wordt via aanbesteding een landschapsarchitectenbureau ingehuurd. Dit bureau stelt in het tweede en derde kwartaal het landschapsplan op. Daarbij wordt de omgeving actief betrokken. Nadere informatie hierover volgt via de projectsite en de digitale nieuwsbrief. Eind 2019 volgt de besluitvorming in Provinciale Staten via een go/no go besluit. Vervolgens neemt ook de minister van OCW een go/no go beslissing.

In het akkoord is de volgende passage opgenomen over de Verbinding A8-A9:

De huidige voorkeursvariant van de verbinding A8-A9 zal verder onderzocht worden. Om het landschap te sparen zal gekeken worden of het mogelijk is de weg verdiept of in een tunnel aan te leggen. In dit onderzoek worden ook klimaatadaptatie en de aansluiting van Krommenie en Assendelft op openbaar vervoer meegenomen. Leidend bij de definitieve keuze voor een voorkeursvariant is het behoud van de Werelderfgoedstatus van de Stelling van Amsterdam.

Om op korte termijn iets te doen aan de grote overlast voor de omwonenden van de N203 bij Krommenie investeren we in de leefbaarheid, bijvoorbeeld in maatregelen om de luchtkwaliteit te verbeteren.

Op 17 juni 2019 vergaderen Provinciale Staten van Noord-Holland over het coalitieakkoord 'Duurzaam doorpakken!' en wordt het nieuwe college geïnstalleerd. Beoogd verantwoordelijk gedeputeerde is de heer Adnan Tekin (PvdA).

In de eerstvolgende vergadering van de stuurgroep Verbinding A8-A9 wordt stilgestaan bij het coalitieakkoord.

Background Paper

World Heritage: Transformation of the Cultural Landscape Towards a Sustainable Future



The Dutch Water Defence Lines is formed by the existing World Heritage site the Defence Line of Amsterdam and the proposed extension with the New Dutch Water Line. Together they form a unique and complete monument of defence of the country with water as an ally. As siteholders we encounter certain challenges concerning the management of this exceptional heritage within a dynamic urban area. There are (dense) urban areas within which new developments must be integrated. The openness and scale of the landscape make it attractive for example for housing, energy transition, recreation and/or infrastructure. We want to prepare for these issues, but it is not always clear what the best way of dealing with these issues is. As this must be a challenge encountered by many other (future) World Heritage sites, we want to share experiences and exchange ideas in order to see if it is possible to establish a strategy.

Objective and aim of the meeting

This international meeting centres around the question on how to deal with urban and/or development pressure on the cultural landscape of World Heritage sites, like for example the Defence Line of Amsterdam. There are ongoing discussions concerning (World Heritage) cities facing challenges due to dynamic urban development, but what about the cultural landscapes, the areas connecting the cities?

There is a pressure for development (e.g. housing quotas, energy transition, infrastructure and recreation). How can a dynamic environment be combined with maintaining the (World) heritage values or even enhancing them?

What are the experiences of other World Heritage sites concerning these challenges? During the meeting we would like to use case studies and discussion to highlight the challenges and potential strategies on how to deal with it. The intention is to discuss this challenge on the various levels, e.g. policy making, planning, design and public support, as it should be an integrated approach if we want to deal with this issue effectively.

The meeting has three main aims:

- Raise awareness regarding the issue of urban and/or development pressure on the cultural landscape;
- share knowledge with other (potential) World Heritage sites;
- working towards a strategy on how to deal with these challenges.

Background to the meeting

Today, the majority of the world's population is living in urban areas, with more people leaving rural areas every day. The United Nations is working on the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and the New Urban Agenda, adopted in October 2016. It acknowledges the integral role of culture across many of the Sustainable Development Goals, including those that commit to quality education, economic growth, sustainable consumption and production patterns, and peaceful and inclusive societies. Culture is directly addressed in Goal 11, which aims to 'make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable', and heritage is specifically mentioned within Target 11.4 which aims to 'strengthen efforts to protect and safeguard the world's cultural and natural heritage'.

As written in the publication *Culture Urban Future* (UNESCO, 2016), 'the New Urban Agenda will have to address the enormous challenges implicit in this transformation, ranging from good-quality housing, creating green public spaces and ensuring infrastructures and services to billions of people, while controlling land consumption, environmental pollution, hazards and risks, epidemics and social disruption'.

The World Heritage Convention (1972) recognises properties of 'Outstanding Universal Value' (OUV) which are part of the 'world heritage of mankind as a whole' in order to pass them on to future generations. This means that the OUV, and the attributes that define them, need to be maintained over time. How do you combine this with the challenges of a dynamic urban area? It is important to emphasise that World Heritage sites do not exist in isolation, there are many factors that directly or indirectly influence the management of the heritage.

The new Dutch National Environmental Planning Strategy (*Nationale Omgevingsvisie* / NOVI) is a long term vision regarding the future and the development of the living environment in the Netherlands. Open space in the Netherlands is scarce whereas the pressure on space is increasing as it is already used for multiple goals or functions at the same time, for example the combination of nature conservation and recreation. Growing population and the accompanying economy and infrastructure, and the challenges of climate adaptation, energy transition and circular economy mean that the open landscape is being looked at with a new perspective. [

The historic urban landscape approach (HUL) is aimed at 'preserving the quality of the human environment, enhancing the productive and sustainable use of urban spaces, while recognizing their dynamic character, and promoting social and functional diversity. It integrates the goals of urban heritage conservation and those of social and economic development. It is rooted in a balanced and sustainable relationship between the urban and natural environment, between the needs of present and future generations and the legacy from the past'. [source: UNESCO (2011), *UNESCO Recommendation on the Historic Urban Landscape*].

The Resource Manuals *Managing Natural World Heritage* and *Managing Cultural World Heritage* are currently being updated. The intention is to share the outcomes of this meeting with the World Heritage Centre and the Advisory Bodies with the request to incorporate them if possible, where applicable and relevant, in the revised texts of these documents.

Challenges

Energy transition is one of the challenges that the Netherlands is dealing with. For example, for the open landscape of the Defence Line of Amsterdam and the Dutch Water Defence Lines, various forms of energy are being explored, like solar panel fields, wind turbines and geothermal energy. UNESCO realises that renewable energy is key for the future, and the RENFORUS initiative looks at, amongst others, the application of sustainable energy within World Heritage. As mentioned on the website 'while addressing climate change mitigation, this initiative will also aim to demonstrate the benefit of harnessing the locally available renewable energy sources and their potential impacts on the environmental and ecological preservation of UNESCO sites'. Recreational pressure is another challenge that needs to be dealt with. The space is limited, and there are several functions to be considered for it. How to ensure that there is not a negative impact on the heritage?

Another challenge is the question of mobility / infrastructure; how to connect the various places, guide the movement of people from one place to another? What is the most economical way, less intrusive for the heritage, etc.

Ideally you want to combine the various functions within the landscape, like for example generating energy along existing infrastructure or combining nature preservation with recreational purposes though this is not always possible. The impact of the above mentioned challenges has to be evaluated per World Heritage site but it might be useful to establish a strategy which can be of assistance to all sites.

Heritage Impact Assessments (HIAs) can assist World Heritage sites to evaluate effectively the impact of potential development on the OUV. It looks at which of the attributes are at risk, how will the change/development impact the OUV, and how can these be avoided, reduced or compensated? So it is not only about limitations but also about opportunities.

Law and regulations can also be a useful tool. Through the new Environment and Planning Act (Omgevingswet) the government of the Netherlands wants to combine and simplify the regulations for spatial projects. For the time being, the Act will replace 15 existing laws, including the Water Act, the Crisis & Recovery Act and the Spatial Planning Act. The provisions of eight other laws will be transferred to the Environment & Planning Act. The expectation is that the Act will take effect in 2021. Through the Environment and Planning Act the Cabinet wants to improve links between different projects and activities (in the fields of spatial planning, the environment and nature), sustainable developments such as locations for wind farms, and the various regions. Thank you very much for your answer and your feedback. We really appreciate your interest; your input is very useful.

We have selected six case studies for the international meeting, by means of looking to the State of Conservation Reports over the last few years, and we have also looked for cases outside Europe. These potential case studies are Stonehenge, Avebury and Associated Sites (UK - presence from the UK is confirmed), Upper Middle Rhine Valley (Germany - presence confirmed), Hill Forts of Rajasthan (India - waiting for response), Lamu Old Town (Kenya - presence confirmed), The Grand Canal (China - waiting for response) and Memphis and its Necropolis – the pyramid fields from Giza (Egypt - waiting for the contact details for the right person from Alcira Sandoval Ruiz).

The SOC reports have shown that they share similar challenges. We have subsequently contacted the regional desk for the contact details for the relevant persons at those World Heritage properties, and asked those persons if they are indeed facing the same challenges at their World Heritage property and if they are willing to contribute to the meeting.

Any other suggestions for possible case studies are always welcome as we might need other ones in case some will not be able to come.

Furthermore, do you have any suggestions for people who could contribute to the meeting, or for whom the meeting is relevant, we could invite? It is for us very important that this will be a truly international meeting, hence

the question. We have also asked ICOMOS international for suggestions, and there will be a limit to the number of Dutch participants. The aim is to send the invitations out by the 9th of December so if we could have the names before then that would be much appreciated.

Finally, we will of course cover your travel expenses from Paris and your accommodation in the Netherlands, if you can participate in this meeting.
